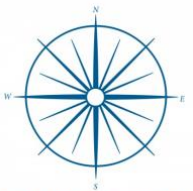

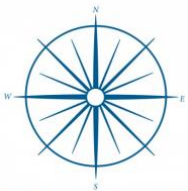
Tēnei mātou e maioha atu nei, e mihi nei, Tēnā rā tātou katoa, manawatia te māhi o te rangatira.

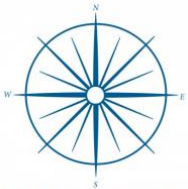
‘Kia kotahi te whakaaro, kia tū tahi ai tātou’

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Te whakangūngū pukenga whutuporo tāhae ripene

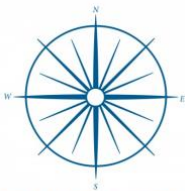

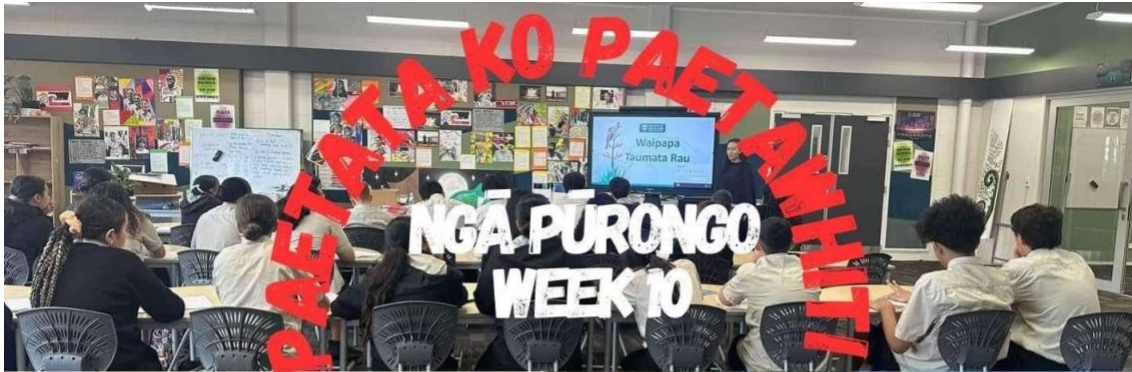

For our non-competitive students, training is still full steam ahead as they focus on building their aerobic fitness and muscular endurance.

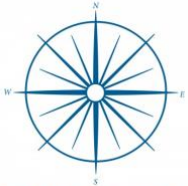

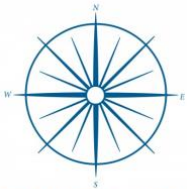

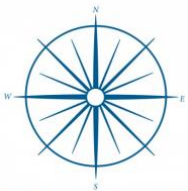
